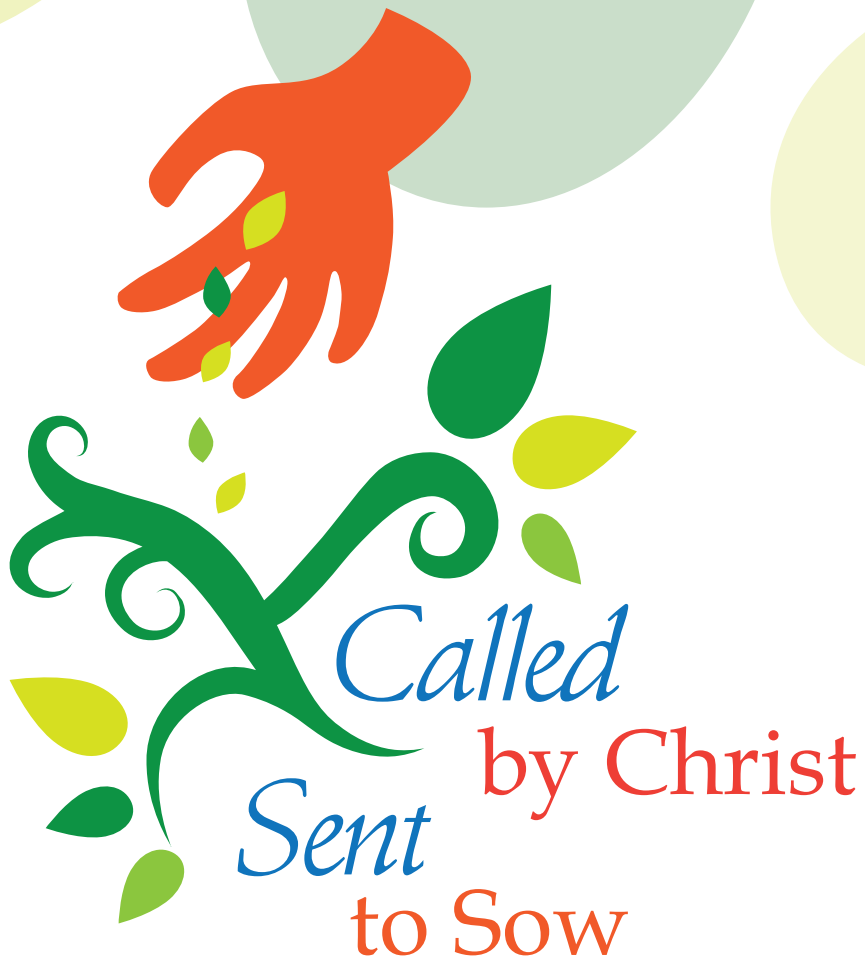

*The Advocacy Access Line is a ministry provided by the Annual Conference to anyone impacted by ministerial sexual misconduct. The line is available as an effort by the conference to assure its care for all parties impacted by sexual misconduct.

The Advocate Access Line is a confidential line that notifies an advocate that a call has been received.

The advocate will attempt to respond within 24 hours. The line offers a compassionate ear without judgment or partiality and offers options for further care if requested; however, the advocate does not act as a professional therapist for the caller. An advocate may also explain the stages of the complaint process if the caller chooses to pursue a complaint.
